Doris Zinzer (age 75) August 1, 1930 - November 26, 2005

Doris was born in Lethbridge, Alberta. She moved to Tillamook, Oregon in 1938, graduating from Tillamook High School. She married David Zinzer in 1948 and they moved to Portland, Oregon where they started State Building Maintenance and cared for many foster children. They adopted three children. In 1978, they purchased the Travelodge motel in Vancouver, Washington which they operated until retiring. They later moved to Independence, Oregon and became members of Monmouth Christian Church. David passed away in 1997 and in 2002 Doris moved to TRH. She volunteered at Turner Elementary School helping with the kindergarten class. She is survived by her three children, eight grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Tim Kribs (age 70) September 17, 1935 - February 9, 2006

Tim was born in Elgin, Oregon to Albert and Mary Kribs. Albert was a minister and they lived at TRH in Eden Circle from 1969-1980. Tim majored in the history of the Bible. He worked for Bell Telephone Company while attending school. He later attended seminary in Indiana, serving a church there for six years. In Oregon, Tim served for four years at Harrisburg Christian Church and 17 years at the Gladstone Christian Church. Prior to serving at Wi-Ne-Ma, he ministered 12 years in Texas. Tim was President of the International Christian Endeavor for two terms. He met Lavonne at Northwest Christian College and they married in 1957. They moved to TRH in 2005 where she currently lives. He is also survived by three children and 10 grandchildren.
